EDNA is an online platform that streamlines disaster management by using a national volunteer network in a cloud call center.





Solutions solved by EDNA

- Active S.O.S. and Storm Alert monitoring for registered users
- Global Distributed Network of Volunteer Responders
- Accessible to all regardless of socio-economic status or tech savvy
- Non-emergency virtual assistance to all callers
- Data collection related to use of disaster relief
- New instance for a city installs instantly at zero cost

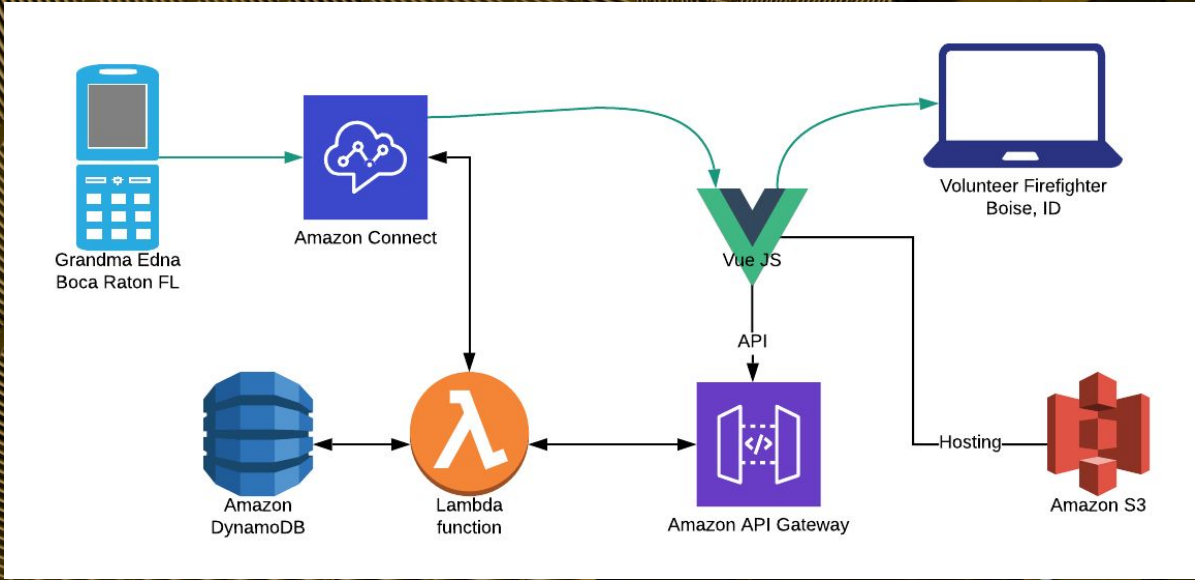


Meet Grandma Edna

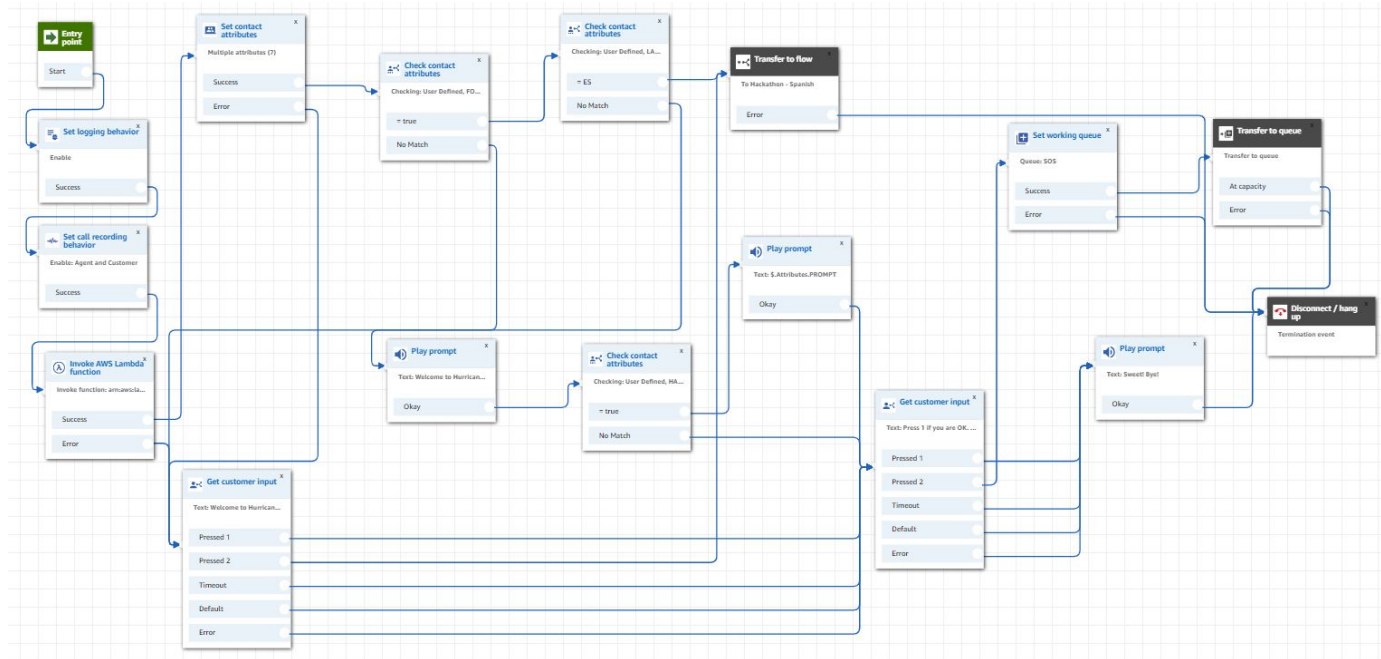
- Registered for S.O.S. and Alert system

Cost Effectiveness

EDNA Call Cost:

\$0.0022 per minute



150 volunteers



4 hours a day for 2 weeks



940 GB of recording



\$1,121 TOTAL
